Counselor – In –Training Program

Under the guidance of a CIT director, teens learn the skills needed to become a camp counselor. Teens will learn theories of child development, how to plan age appropriate activities and all other skills needed to become a competent counselor. The camp offers course Level I through Level III. Each program level will include 3 weeks of field work and class time. Levels II & III are designed to give more field experience and instructional work. Participants will receive 2 staff t-shirts and name tag while participating in this camp. Participants may also choose to stay during the Early/Late program for free if they assist staff and supervise the program. Teens completing each course level will receive a certificate of recognition. **Participants in this camp are not guaranteed future camp employment at Casperkill.**
