Special Events CIT Program “New”

Under the guidance of a CIT Special Events director, teens learn the skills needed to offer events that are special throughout the camps. Teens will take pictures for the newspaper, shoot videos for the end of the week production and interview counselors and campers. Participants of this program will get involved in preparing for all the special events offered during camp. Between events participants in this program will be assigned to a camp group as a CIT (see following page). Participants will be given a Special Events T-Shirt and name tag while participating in this camp. Participants may also choose to stay during the Early/Late program for free if they assist staff and supervise the program. Teens completing each course level will receive a Special Events Certificate of Recognition.

Counselor - In -Training Program

Under the guidance of a CIT director, teens learn the skills needed to become a camp counselor. Teens will learn theories of child development, how to plan age appropriate activities and all other skills needed to become a competent counselor. The camp offers course Level I through Level III. Each program level will include 3 weeks of field work and class time. Levels II & III are designed to give more field experience and instructional work. Participants will receive 2 staff t-shirts and a name tag while participating in this camp. Participants may also choose to stay during the Early/Late program for free if they assist staff and supervise the program. Teens completing each course level will receive a certificate of recognition. **Participants in this camp are not guaranteed future camp employment at Casperkill.**
